

# Post-Primary Teaching (UK) Entry 2020

#### **Entry Requirements**

Ordinary Grade C (England)/Grade B (Wales) in English and Mathematics - check with individual colleges for specific

**England-** Entry requirements Wales - Entry Requirements **Scotland** - Entry Requirements

GCSE equates to Ordinary Level Leaving Certificate and qualification equivalents.

If you do not hold the Leaving Certificate requirements, some institutions may offer special equivalence tests - check with individual colleges

#### **Additional Entry Requirements -**

School based observation (minimum 2 days) is expected. Observation in a number of schools is preferred. Applicants will be expected to demonstrate relevance of their degree to the Curriculum.

# **Application England & Wales:**

Centralised application- UCAS Teacher Training Application Fee - £25 Sterling (tbc) for up to 3 courses Applications open from mid October. There is no closing date. Some courses will fill up quickly, it is advisable to apply early.

Centralised application- UCAS Undergraduate Application Fee - £20 for one course or £25 for up to 5 choices Closing date 15th January 2020.

#### **Routes into Teaching**

While there are a number of routes (university based and school based) leading to qualification as a Post-Primary teacher in the UK, to be eligible to register with the Irish Teaching Council, the route you choose must provide both an academic qualification, e.g. Postgraduate/Professional Certificate in Education PGCE (England/Wales) / the Postgraduate Diploma in Education (Scotland) AND Qualified Teacher Status (QTS).

Qualifications gained outside Ireland must be assessed by the Irish Teaching Council. There may be shortfalls in the comparison of qualifications obtained in the UK versus Irish teacher education qualifications. Tuition fees of up to £9,000. Students in England, Wales and Northern Ireland can apply to the Student Loan Company to pay these fees directly to university. This is payable to Student Loan Company, on completion of the course, once the newly qualified teacher is working and earning more than a specified amount "repayment threshold".
